Soroptimist International of Oceanside-Carlsbad was chartered in 1947 to “foster the ideal of service.” In the past 60 plus years, we have grown to a membership of over 85 community leaders dedicated to promoting awareness of the needs of our community and working to address those needs, particularly those concerning women and girls.

Once again, Soroptimist International of Oceanside-Carlsbad is accepting applications from community service organizations such as yours who are eligible for consideration for our annual Community Service Grants. Our grant program has been modified from previous years to award larger sums of money, ranging from \$3,500-\$15,000 per agency, with the goal of making a larger collective impact! However, we are limiting the number of agencies that receive monies to 3-5 organizations. We invite your agency to participate in this process. In keeping with our mission and the focus “Educate to Lead”, **only applications that will provide or enhance services exclusively for women and girls pertaining to “Educate to Lead” who live in Oceanside, Camp Pendleton or Carlsbad** will be considered.

Applications, including current budget information, must be **received no later than March 31, 2018**. Because we have limited funds and want to ensure that all applicants are treated fairly, you must have submitted a completed application and supporting documentation as needed by the deadline in order to be considered for a monetary award.
